The Texas Natural Resources Information System (TNRIS) and the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) teamed with Google to bring Google Imagery Services to the State of Texas. The year one pilot is fully funded by the Texas Department of Transportation, The Commission on State Emergency Communications, the Texas Water Development Board, and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Local Regional Governments, as well as state universities, are invited to participate and test the Google Imagery Service for free during the pilot year.
- 3. Looking Into Lucity: GIS Integrated Software Providing Solutions For Public Works & Beyond.**

Rebecca Moore is a May 2014 graduate from the University of Texas at Austin where she received her Bachelors in Geography. She now serves as the Utilities Information Systems Specialist for the City of Cedar Park where she combines her interests in GIS, engineering systems, and problem solving to offer more efficient solutions, geospatial analysis, and technical support for the city's public works department. Ms. Moore has led the mobile application deployment and overall system integration of the city's GIS data into their current public works management software, Lucity. She continues to develop innovative ways to expand the city's use of Lucity and GIS while working to include additional systems integration opportunities. Her presentation, "Looking into Lucity" touches on the journey the Cedar Park's public works department has undertaken to better manage their resources and streamline data records. The implementation of Lucity and integration of GIS has provided a wide variety of city users with increased efficiency as well as customized analysis to improve current and future decision making.
